a. SOA Quantar Replacement/Separation Study. At the July meeting, Mr. John Rockwell briefed the Quantars are at their end of life in FY2020, from a Motorola perspective, and in order to move forward beyond the 7.17 platform we need to upgrade them. He reminded the council this cost was first introduced a three years ago and not funded, then again two years ago it was not funded, and it was not funded again last year; he added the DOD has already upgraded their Quantars, so the State is either going to have to separate and/or do something different. Mr. Rockwell encouraged the council to approve the budget (which they did) and communicate its importance up to the Governor's office.

b. State Interoperability Governing Body (SIGB). At the July meeting, Mr. Rockwell stated the package made it through the legal review, the National Governor's Association was meeting next week and would be discussing this issue with other

states, and once they completed this discussion, the package would go back to the Governor's office.

c. 9-1-1 Enhancement Proposal. At the July meeting, Mr. Rockwell advised there was \$3.5M in the Governor's Budget for this project and had passed Phase 1. He added there are still some unknowns at this time, but the project was progressing.
