**Alaska Land Mobile Radio
System Incident Response Policy**

1. Applicability

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, sub-contractors, consultants, temporary employees and other personnel assigned to or utilizing the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System. Any substantial revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

2. Policy


ALMR shall have a computer security incident response capability to address required actions for the creation, implementation and management of an Incident Response Team (IRT) to address computer security incidents including, but not limited to, theft, misuse of data, intrusions, hostile probes and malicious software.

3. Procedures

In response to a System incident, the System Manager, in consultation and coordination with the Security Manager and the Operations Manager, shall determine the severity of the incident, notify the appropriate personnel, activate an IRT and perform all required actions in accordance with the ALMR System Incident Response Procedure 400-2.

4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
