Encryption Terms

- **AES** Advanced Encryption Standard
- **CKR** Common Key Reference
- **DES** Data Encryption Standard – NOT NSA authorized
- **KVL** Key Variable Loader
- **KMC** Key Management Controller
- **KMF** Key Management Facility
- **UKEK** Unique Key Encryption Key

Encryption Concerns

- AES is the only NSA certified key material
- Degraded audio quality
- Degraded signal – lower range
- Everyone has it?
 - Internal
 - Other agencies
- They're listening - www.radioreference.com

Encryption Concerns

- Method of loading fills
 - OTAR
 - KVL
- Forced Encryption – Non-selectable
- Day one Encryption
- Duplicate CKRs

Clearing Encryption

- Methods of clearing encryption:
 - Remove Battery with power on
 - Should be immediate (Less than 10 minutes)
 - Leave battery off
 - Should be a few minutes. (Less than 30 min)
 - Buttons switches and menu items can be programmed to clear all or some of the keys
